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Introduction

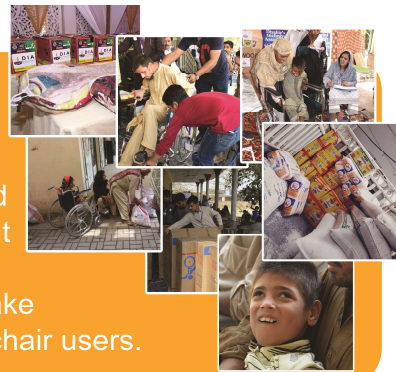
Disables Inclusive Association (DIA) with PWDs is a non-profit cross disability and inclusive association which supports People enabling them to realize their full potential through new opportunities, personal choice, and community involvement. The association is working for improving the ultimate status with dignity of people with disabilities. DIA is focused on Independent Living, Barrier Free & Right-Based Society, Inclusive Education, health issues and "Access to Justice" for all.

Main Objectives

- The purpose of the association is to provide appropriate and individualized developmental services to the whole person to foster independent and semi-independent living.
- To promote the equalization of opportunities of disabled persons through strengthening their self-representation at all levels as a means of ensuring their full participation and integration in society.
- To provide different types of aids, equipment, and assistive technology such as wheelchairs, walking stick, walkers, tricycle, white cane etc.
- To provide skilled people with different articles like sewing machine and loans for earning of livelihood to make them financially independent.

Achivements

DIA Welfare Association has distributed around hundreds of wheelchairs, assistive devices and sewing machines, arranged marriage of orphan girls, distributed Ramadan rashan and arranged sehri, ifatri drives on every Ramadan at different locations. DIA Welfare Association worked on inclusive development and accessibility and make different schools/collages accessible for wheelchair users.



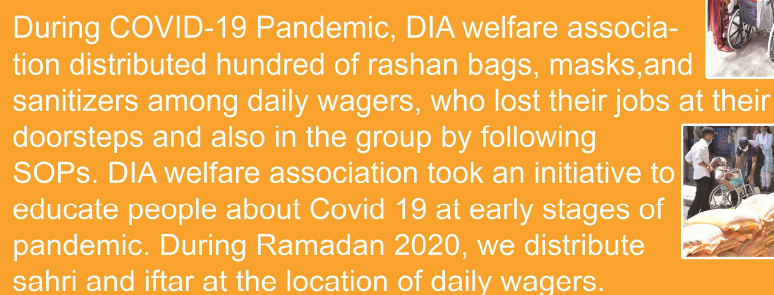
DIA's Role During COVID-19

During COVID-19 Pandemic, DIA welfare association distributed hundred of rashan bags, masks, and sanitizers among daily wagers, who lost their jobs at their doorsteps and also in the group by following SOPs. DIA welfare association took an initiative to educate people about Covid 19 at early stages of pandemic. During Ramadan 2020, we distribute sahri and iftar at the location of daily wagers.





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Supportive attitude expected from society

- People should avoid stigmatization of disabled people and should consider them as equal. The stigma around disability severely affects people with disability's sense of culture and identity.
- Non-disabled people need to be led by, respect, and affirm each person with a disability's choice of language they use about themselves.
- The legal rights and interests of people with disabilities should be protected, they should get equal opportunity to participate in social, political, economical, and cultural activities fairly.
- The authorities in charge of sports are responsible for the planning, implementation, and supervision of the affairs and issues concerning sports activities, locations, facilities, equipment and unique exercise in favor of people with disabilities.
- People with disabilities shall not be discriminated against on the rights and interests of education, (examination) participation, employment, and residence.
- Appropriate measures should be taken to encourage and promote participation, to the fullest extent possible, of persons with disabilities in mainstream sporting activities at all levels.
- People with disabilities should be allowed to observe and participate in everyday activities of a workplace to gain some experience similar to that of normal people.
- It should be ensured that people with a disability get required from the organization.
